
## Ballard Sunset Hills – Jan 15 2019 (5.3 miles)



- Start from the **Ballard Coffee Works**, 2060 NW Market St.
- Cross Market at Leary and proceed east. Across Market are the Majestic Bay Theater, opened in 1915, the oldest continuously operating movie theater west of the Mississippi and Ballard Carnegie Library Bldg, 1904-63, now open as a restaurant.
- Turn right on Russell Ave and pass the Old Firehouse built in 1911, now also a restaurant.
- Continue southeast on Russell. Then turn left through a pedestrian passage to Tallman Ave, and Swedish Hospital.
- Turn right on Tallman to the intersection of 17th Ave., the location of KBGF radio.
- Proceed north on 17th Ave.
- Walk through the **Ballard Corners Park** between 62<sup>nd</sup> and 63<sup>rd</sup> Streets.
- Cross 65<sup>th</sup> St. We are entering the Loyal Heights section of Ballard named after real estate developer Harry Treat's daughter, Loyal. He began the Loyal trolley line and built an amusement park at Loyal (later Golden) Gardens to attract prospective buyers.
- Turn left on 70<sup>th</sup> St. and enter **Salmon Bay Park** designed by the **Olmsted** brothers. Walk through the Park to the northwest. Keep an eye out for large Douglas fir trees in the area which hint at the earlier environment.
- Exit the park and continue north on 22 Ave to 77<sup>th</sup> St. to the **Loyal Heights Playfields and Community Center** and **BATHROOMS**.
- Exiting the Community Center and continue west on 77<sup>th</sup> and cross 24<sup>th</sup> Ave. Then north on 28<sup>th</sup>
  Ave and cross 80<sup>th</sup> St. to Loyal Way. Loyal Way follows the tracks of the old trolley line to Loyal
  (Golden) Gardens.
- Cross 32 Ave and turn south.
- Turn west on  $80^{\text{th}}$  then south on  $33^{\text{rd}}$  then west again on  $77^{\text{th}}$  to **Sunset Hills Park**.
- Walk along the bluffs overlooking Puget Sound and continue south on 34<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Turn left on 65th St; cross 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave and continue south to 64th St.
- Continue east on 64th then turn south on 30th Ave.
- Turn east on 58<sup>th</sup> St. and walk into Thyme Patch Park, a Seattle P-Patch.
- Continue on 58<sup>th</sup> St., cross 24<sup>th</sup> Ave, and continue to the Ballard Commons Park featuring a skate bowl and water fountain.
- Turn south on 22<sup>nd</sup> Ave and pass the Ballard Public Library. It was designed by Bohlin Cywinski
  Jackson. The "green roof" is planted with more than 18,000 low-water-use plants; a computergenerated artwork uses data from sensors on the roof to create LED displays triggered by sunlight,
  rain, and wind.
- The Ballard Coffee Works is on the corner of 22<sup>nd</sup> and Market right across from the historic Eagles Building.
